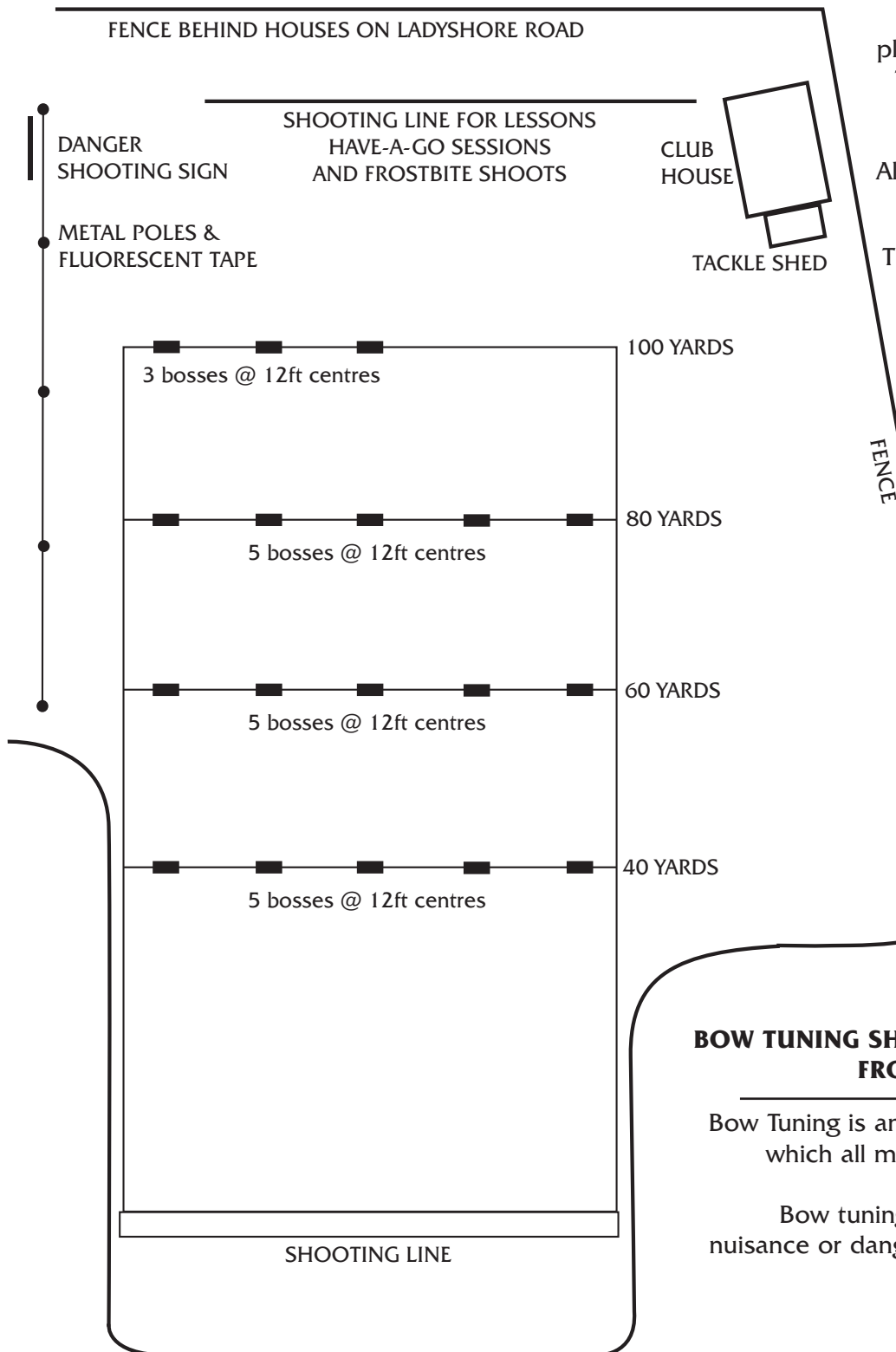


• SHOOTING AT OVERDALE •

- **ALWAYS THINK SAFETY WHEN SHOOTING AT OVERDALE •**
- **MEMBERS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COMPETENT ADULT BEFORE ANY SHOOTING CAN TAKE PLACE.**



Before any shooting takes place the Poles, Fluorescent Tape and Danger Shooting Sign must be put out.

All shooting should be done from the shooting line.

There are however possible exceptions to this.

A - Beginners Classes.

B - Have-a-Go or similar sessions.

C - Frostbite Shoots.

Beginners classes, Have-a-Go sessions and frostbite Shoots are held at the shooting line shown alongside the Club House.

When these are taking place no other shooting is allowed.

BOW TUNING SHOULD ONLY TAKE PLACE FROM THE SHOOTING LINE

Bow Tuning is an important part of archery which all members are encouraged to practice.

Bow tuning must not however cause nuisance or danger to other club members or members of the public.

• THE FOLLOWING PRIORITIES SHOULD BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES •

During Tuesday, Thursday or Sunday club day shooting times, general practice or the shooting of rounds must be given preference. Bow tuning can still take place as long as there are not too many members crowded onto the

available bosses. In case of dispute the field Captain has to decide.

On Saturday, Monday, Wednesday and Friday bow tuning can be given equal priority with the shooting of rounds and general practice.
